Thank you for supporting this tournament, this city and the beautiful sport of roller derby.

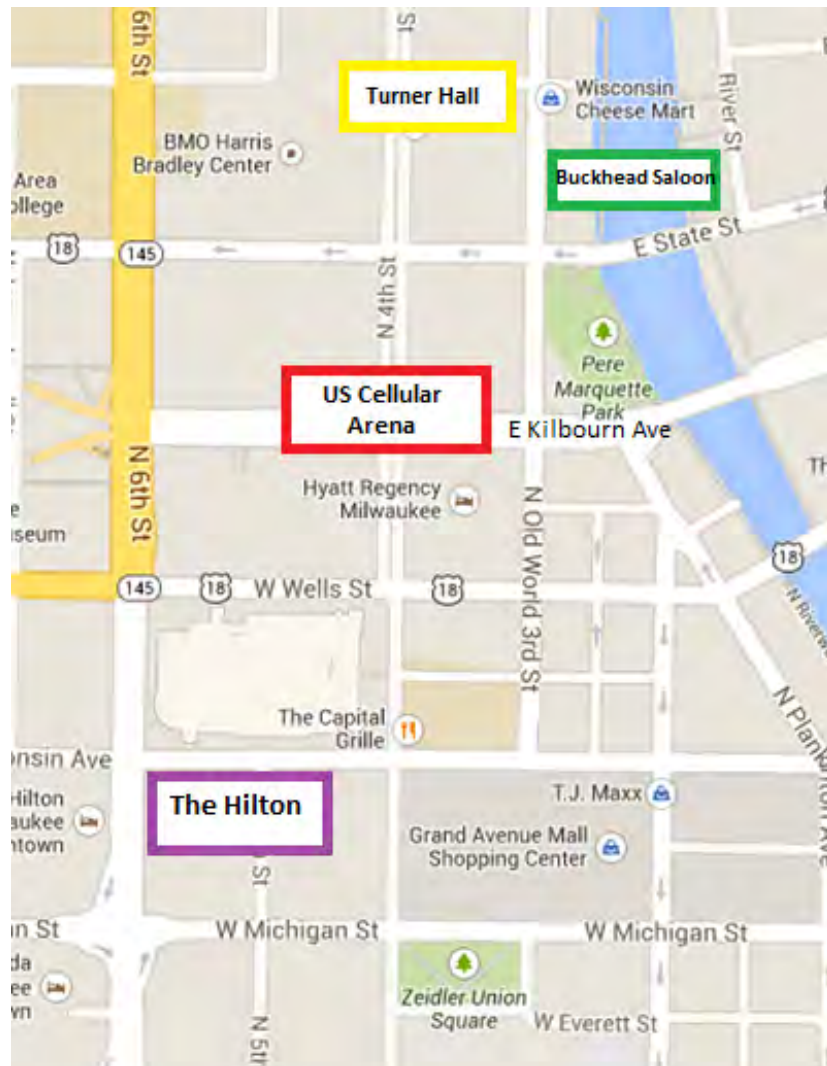

## Transportation:

**TOURNAMENT SHUTTLE - N/A**

It is 0.3 miles from the tournament hotel to the venue. It should take you less time to get from the hotel to the venue than a full jam.



## **AIRPORT SHUTTLE - N/A**

The Downtown Hilton does not have an airport shuttle. If you're not renting a car and not taking a taxi, the Milwaukee County Transit System GREEN LINE bus runs between the Airport and Bayshore Mall (which is north of downtown).

**Public Transit (city bus):** This is the most economical way to tour our city. Route maps can be found at [www.ridemcts.com](http://www.ridemcts.com). Here are a couple quick routes:

- The G (Green Line) bus picks up at the corner of Wisconsin and Water. The fare is \$2.25; they accept change and dollar bills. These bus stops on different sides of the street depending upon the time of day check the posted sign.

- The G (Green Line) travels north (towards Bayshore Mall) through the Milwaukee neighborhoods of the East Side (Oakland and North stop), past the UWM campus to Bayshore Mall.
- The G (Green Line) travels south (towards the Airport) through Walker's Point (1<sup>st</sup> and National stop) and Bayview (Howell and Lincoln stop) to the airport.

## **MILWAUKEE NEIGHBORHOODS:**

Like many cities its size, Milwaukee is a mosaic of neighborhoods, each with its own character and flavor. We have listed a few of our favorites here, with those closest to the Hyatt listed first.
