BREW CITY BRUISERS START 2017 INTERLEAGUE SEASON SATURDAY WITH TRIPLE-HEADER

(MILWAUKEE) - Milwaukee's roller derby league, the Brewcity Bruisers, begin their exciting 2017 season this Saturday, February 18, at the Wisconsin Products Pavilion at Wisconsin State Fair Park (640 S 84th Street, West Allis). The event features all three of Milwaukee's interleague teams in a triple header: Brewcity Micro Bruisers vs. Quad City Orphan Brigade, Brewcity Bruisers Battlestars vs. Pikes Peak Slamazons, and Brewcity Bruisers All Stars vs. Pikes Peak All Stars. The first bout begins at 4 p.m., doors open at 3 p.m.

"We're excited to be back at Wisconsin Products Pavilion this season," said Nicole Armendariz, Brewcity Bruisers Media Coordinator. "This year we plan to introduce this unique sport to even more people and continue to expand our ever-growing fan base."

The Milwaukee interleague roller derby regular season will run through late summer. The schedule includes the Midwest BrewHaHa international roller derby tournament in Milwaukee, June 2-4.
